Dear Sir or Madam,

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to attend a public meeting concerning improvements to State Road 12 from S.R. 10 (U.S. 90/Jefferson Street in Quincy) to S.R. 63 (US 27/Main Street in Havana). Also included is the section of S.R. 159 from S.R. 12 to S.R. 63 (U.S. 27). Two meetings will be held, the first on Tuesday October 11, 2011 from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM at the Havana Public Library (203 East Fifth Avenue), and the second on Thursday October 13, 2011, from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM at City of Quincy City Hall (404 West Jefferson Street). These public meetings will provide you an opportunity to preview the proposed design, ask questions, and/or submit comments concerning the upcoming projects. Maps, drawings, and other information will be on display. There will be no formal presentation. Representatives from FDOT will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

This project is approximately 11.5 miles in length and is currently funded in fiscal year 2014. The proposed improvements include resurfacing existing travel lanes, parking lanes and paved shoulders along S.R. 12. Other improvements include repairing deficient sidewalks, replacing curb ramps and upgrading pedestrian signal features to meet the current standards set by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). The Department is also considering minor widening of S.R. 12 between Washington Street and Franklin Street and is seeking feedback from the community. The intent of this widening is to increase the width of the existing travel lanes and improve the traffic flow and safety.

FDOT is required to give notice to those whose property lies, in whole or in part, within 300 feet on either side of the centerline of the proposed facility even though they might not be directly affected. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status. Persons who require special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act or persons who require translation services (free of charge) should contact Clay Hunter or Scott Golden at (888) 638-0250 at least seven days prior to the meeting.
